Laura recalls some of the more famous performances of her idols including Fred Astaire, Gene Kelly, Ann Miller, Eleanor Powell and Sammy Davis Jr., with jazz interpretations of music and lyrics by Cole Porter, The Gershwins, Johnny Mercer, Irving Berlin, Burton Lane, Richard Whiting and Jerome Kern. With humorous personal anecdotes, interesting historical information about the films in which the dancers starred, as well as a little hoofing, Laura keeps the audience completely engaged throughout the evening.
